This fall and winter Cocker Spaniel Resources, Inc (CSR) has taken in 30 cockers from a collector. The dogs were well fed, but not cared for properly. In a week or two we will be getting **another 20 or so dogs** from this same person. These cockers are very social, so we know they were loved to some degree; however, their medical issues were not addressed.

CSR is not equipped to take this many cockers into its rescue without help from former adopters and the general public. CSR needs help with donations of goods, supplies and monetary donations. CSR volunteers have put together a list of items which are needed to make it better for each one of these 50 dogs.

VETERINARY SUPPLIES:

- Bottles of chlorhexide for soaking wounds
- Optimmune eye meds which cost \$35 per tube; prescription only
- Eyewash over-the-counter for flushing eyes prior to adding Optimmune
- Ear cleaner
- Real cotton balls
- Gauze wrap

MAJOR SURGERIES

Monetary gifts are desperately needed.

Here are the estimated costs of some of the surgeries needed by these dogs. The cost includes surgeries for several dogs.

If there are more than three ablations, the cost will jump \$1,000 per dog.

- Ablations of ears at least \$3,000
--- Eye surgeries \$1000
--- Tumor biopsies \$500
--- Hernia Repairs \$800
--- Teeth cleaning & extraction \$3,000

TRANSPORTATION

Volunteers are needed to transport the dogs to and from their surgeries and vet appointments.

FOSTER HOMES

We need foster homes in Minnesota, Wisconsin or Iowa for these dogs. Some cockers have already learned what it means to live in a home. The 17 cockers which came last Saturday and the ones coming in a couple of weeks have never lived outside of a cage!

HOW THE LAST DOGS LOOKED UPON ARRIVAL

These dogs were fed, but there was no grooming and their medical needs were not addressed. These are two of the dogs we recently received. Keep in mind that we will soon have a total of 50 dogs...all in relatively the same condition!

Frenchie's ear has grown shut from all the ear infections and the ear needs ablation surgery. The second picture shows another cocker with oozing ears. He may also need ablation.

These dogs come to us as complete messes, but a lot of love and extra grooming soon has them looking better. However, these are the easier issues. It's the medical problems that stretch our budget to its limit. Any help you can give will be greatly appreciated.
