Our capacity is only as many foster homes available at any one time. Usually maximum of 9 foster homes and 9 cocker spaniels and/or mixes.

Our geographic area for adoptions: Generally in IA, MN and WI. These are the same states, in which we rescue cockers and cocker spaniel mixes.

We do not charge a fee for transfer of cockers from organizations, however we do request a donation of \$25.00 from private surrenders.

We are not a referral service.

**OUR ORGANIZATION'S PHILOSOPHY:**

We have an age requirement for adoptions. All adopters must be over the age of 18. We also request that any children in the family be over the age of 8 years. We do make exceptions on a case-by-case request.

The circumstances under which we deem a cocker to be unadoptable with the general public:

**We do not take dogs with a history of biting. Our liability insurance will not cover our organization.**

We do use euthanasia as an option. The following are our reasons/circumstances for using euthanasia:  
XX Severely injured    XX Life-threatening illness (i.e.Parvo)    XX Elderly    XX Bite Cases  
XX When the animal's quality of life is severely affected.

**We require 3 people to sign the dog's euthanasia form.** The three people include one board member, another member of the organization familiar with the dog's case, and the attending veterinarian.

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We micro-chip our cockers to track them. We use Home Again, 24PetWatch.com, Res Q, and AVID.

We spenuter (spay/neuter) all dogs prior to adoption. There are no exceptions for dogs over the age of 4 months unless the dog is over age ten and its quality of life would be threatened. For babies under the age of 4 months we have a foster-to-adopt program in which, we do not release the dog for adoption until it is spenutered. The adoption contract is signed only after proof of sterilization.

Our Foster-to-Adopt program ensures the adoption will last. Adopters pay up front for the dog and sign a Foster-to-Adopt Interim Agreement. During the first 5 weeks of the adoption the dog is considered a foster and contact is maintained with the new family on a daily, semi-weekly or weekly basis. If there are problems we try to help with options, if anytime during the five weeks the adopters say, "I just isn't going to work." We take the dog back and refund their adoption fee completely.
